3. Approval of Minutes

3.1. Committee action approving the LakeComm Law Enforcement Chiefs Advisory minutes from March 4, 2026.

A motion to Approve the Minutes from March 4, 2026, was made by Member Prus, seconded by Member Guttschow. The motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

4. Public Comment

There was no Public Comment.

5. Executive Director Updates

Director Kern expressed appreciation for the show of support from the agencies during Telecommunicator's Week. Kern provided an overview of a correspondence from the Sheriff's Department to JETSB. He provided an update that ASAP-to-PSAP is live and currently being fine-tuned. It was also mentioned that Drone as a First Responder integration with CAD for Paladin and Brinc are being finalized. The group was informed

that LakeComm was in the process of transferring Motorola Command Central Aware from the legacy ETSB. There will be a need to remove or limit access to individuals and there may be a need to initiate some MOUs between agencies and LakeComm. Kern opened a discussion about outdoor warning sirens and whether the source of activation is tornado warnings or wind speed and advised staff was looking into notifications, so we were aware when community sirens were activated. Kern provided dates in May for data center migration and outages. Kern provided an overview of LakeComm staffing, as well as call distribution.

6. Unfinished Business

6.1 Radio Alias Discussion

Director Kern provided an update, stating that shift supervisor Tim Stencel is working with Andrew Katzner to coordinate alias information which will be entered into the Motorola system using existing ICCLC standards.

7. New Business

7.1 CAD-to-CAD

Director Kern provided an overview of the software solutions for CAD-to-CAD, including Central Square and Tyler. Currently, LakeComm is working with Glenview to implement a CAD-to-CAD connection to enhance some responses.

7.2 CESSA

Director Kern provided an overview of the Community Emergency Services and Supports Act and informed the Committee that the State had placed LakeComm in Cohort 3 with a goal to go live with additional EMD protocols and processes in early July.

7.3 Pending Chair Vacancy

Chair Seeley announced that he will be retiring and thus stepping down from the role of Committee Chair and invited members to volunteer.

8. Member Remarks

Member Prus inquired about STEP Grants, and about TC's and agencies doing status checks. Director Kern stated that he would look into those concerns. Member Holubetz inquired about a few specific calls, discussion ensued.

9. Adjournment

A motion to Adjourn the Meeting was made at 2:53 PM by Member Guttschow, seconded by Member Prus. The motion carried unanimously by voice vote.
